Southeast Recycling Group to Acquire Sisk Scrap Recycling

August 25, 2025 – Southeast Recycling Group (SRG) will acquire Sisk Scrap Recycling (Sisk), a family operated scrap metal processor with locations in Duncan, SC and Gaffney, SC. The transaction is expected to close September 30, 2025.

SRG will operate from five locations – two in North Carolina and three in South Carolina – along the Interstate 85 corridor and employee over 150 people. SRG processing capabilities will expand to more than 175,000 GT of ferrous scrap and 150,000,000 lbs of nonferrous scrap annually.

Sisk was established in 1947 by family patriarch Ed M Sisk. The company is currently operated by Travis and Eric Knight (third generation) along with Jordan Knight (fourth generation), all of whom will continue in leadership roles with SRG.

We are interested in growing our business and the acquisition of Sisk is a great fit with their strategic locations and family culture," said Paul Siegel, CEO of SRG. "We can really appreciate their sustained success over a very long period of time."

Travis Knight, President of Sisk, added: "Letting go of Sisk Recycling after so many years was not an easy decision, but we found the right partners to continue our family's journey in the scrap metal business."

SRG was formed on January 1, 2025 with the merger of Carolina Metals Group and Spartan Recycling Group, two companies whose six owners each have over 30 years of industry experience.
